Infant and child policy – Dinner at Alexander restaurant

Alexander is a gastronomic restaurant; our guests appreciate to enjoy a wonderful evening at the table with good food, nice wines and great company. Expect your dinner to last between 2 to 3 hours. Therefore we have set certain rules with regards to infants and children during dinner in restaurant Alexander.

Guests with children above the age of 6 are most welcome at Alexander, as we firmly believe that it is a good thing to learn about the pleasures of good food already at an early age. However we expect children to be well behaved and respectful to other guests. If children start screaming or running around, we will kindly ask you to step out of the restaurant until the child has calmed down. Crayons and toys are not permitted in the restaurant. Infants and children under the age of 6 can out of respect for other guests unfortunately not be seated in Alexander restaurant during dinnertime, we do hope for your understanding. During breakfast and lunch they are most welcome in Alexander.

As our policy might be too strict for many children –and the length of the dinner too boring for them- we offer the following alternatives:

- Nanny service – book a nanny with us who will be with your children while you enjoy dinner. A service charge of 300 EEK - 19 € per hour with a minimum of two hours applies.
- In room dining – If you prefer we can serve your children in the comfort of their room. A room service supplement applies.
- Private dining room – Book our private dining room in the wine tasting cellar of the Manor House. There is no extra charge for this service.

We will be more than happy to set up a play-table for your children in the hallway of the Manor House during dinnertime. Crayons and paper for coloring come along with our compliments.
