


Creature comforts

Since it first opened in 1997, the manor house has been painstakingly restored with the concept of supreme comfort and understated luxury in mind. While the spa focuses on using

local traditions and fresh ingredients, the Alexander Restaurant is also noteworthy for its Nordic Island cuisine. With respect for the seasons and working with the island's producers and farmers, the hotel restaurant combines urban sophistication with countryside traditions.
