Omar Massa

Omar born 1981 in Buenos Aires - Argentina. At seven, he made his debut at the 'Café Tortoni' - a famous tango house in Buenos Aires - playing Astor Piazzola's music. Omar entered the National Conservatory of Music when he was only 12 years old and studied bandoneon.

In March 2011, Omar accompanied Plácido Domingo before 120.000 people, in an acclaimed public concert on Buenos Aires' most famous avenue, 9 de Julio.

Omar played in several important concert halls and theatres in Europe, Asia and the Americas. Lincoln Center (New York), the National Concert Hall (Dublin - Ireland) and the National Theatre La Castellana (Bogotá - Colombia).

In 2014 Omar was nominated for the Gardel Music Awards (the most important award in the recording industry in Argentina) for his CD 'Tribute to Piazzolla'.

Omar Massa met Estonian saxophonist Villu Veski and accordionist Tiit Kalluste in Berlin 2001 and invited them to visit him. Thanks to this invitation, Villu Veski and Tiit Kalluste travelled to Buenos Aires to listen and meet Tango musicians. Villu and Tiit wrote Tango compositions during the stay in Buenos Aires, met with Pipi Piazzolla and established their well known project 'Tango Nuevo'.

Matthias Diether

Matthias Diether, Pädaste Manor embraces traditions and dedication in the pursuit of excellence. Our Nordic Islands' Cuisine - full with regional honesty - has opened itself up and joined the prominent list of cooking styles of the world. Matthias born in Berlin but raised in southern Germany gained his professional knowledge with the great chefs of that country: veteran Lothar Eiermann (Schlosshotel Friedrichsruhe); the German kitchen stars Harald Wohlfahrt (Traube Tonbach) and Dieter Müller (Schlosshotel Lerbach), and the shooting star Sven Elverfeld (Aqua Wolfsburg).

Diether tracked out into the world: he managed the gourmet kitchens in Dubai for the Ritz Carlton, the Emirates Palace and the Shangri-La and led the kitchen of Turnberry Resort in Ireland before moving to the pulsating German capital Berlin where he found his signature restaurant in 2010. In the First Floor, he was able to perfect his artistic, elegant cooking style that characterises him today.

Delicate aromas, the best produce, sometimes opulent, sometimes subtle and tenderly staged... made him in Berlin the culinary favourite of the city. And today he is on the way to establish his culinary home in Estonia ... he has fallen in love with our naturalness and our passion for the unique regional cuisine in Estonia, on Muhu Island.
