The Manor House at Pädaste

The Manor House of the Pädaste Estate has undergone an extensive and painstaking restoration, re-instating the dignity and nobility the house held for centuries. This exquisite Manor House set in Idyllic Baltic seaside parkland, had been left totally untouched for decades.

Over the last fifteen years it has been saved from dereliction and slowly re-awakened, culminating in the fundamental 2-year restoration project, which was completed in June 2008. The origins of the manor go back to the 14th century; some of these ancient walls are at the very heart of the house. In the latter part of the 19th century the house was enlarged considerably and given a new façade, hence the harmonious dimensions and clean lines which give the house its character today. The Manor House is the latest building of the Pädaste Estate that has been entirely renovated. Following extensive restoration works of the Pädaste Yacht Club, the former dairy that houses the Spa, the Carriage House and of course the fabulous Private Farm House, finally the glorious Manor itself opened in June 2008 for the enjoyment of our guests.

'Simple Luxury' has served us well as our mission statement and our philosophy since first opening Pädaste Manor in 1997 - this 'Leitmotiv' is once more a key element for the rebirth of the Manor House. There are no ostentatious displays of glamour, thick wall-to-wall carpets or gold plated taps. Yet the noble character of the Manor is fully acknowledged and honored, the dignity and fine character of the building is emphasized by furnishing the house with an appropriate sense of understatement. Sumptuous bespoke bedding and luxuriant fabrics set the tone and exquisite antiques are comfortable next to modern classics. Natural materials and textures are tactile and inviting, giving a lucid quality and very particular character to this unique Baltic Manor. As one would expect, the precious soul of Pädaste Estate has moved back into the Manor House, where our guests will find a very distinct sense of place.

Pädaste is delighted to offer a total of 24 rooms and suites, providing exquisite accommodation of inspired diversity and ranging from cozy rooms in the Carriage House to the grandeur of the Manor House. The estate is a haven of peace with wonderful places to relax and dream, yet it also inspires to exercise and explore, it invites to experience a very individual Spa concept and finest dining options. Above all there is the ambience, the charm and the service expertise that can only be found in a privately owned hotel. You will be one of the privileged few.

The rooms are beautifully appointed with luxuriant fabrics, latest technology and much attention to detail. The beds are sumptuous and you'll walk on ancient wooden floors - you will love them! All the Superior Junior Suites in the Manor House and the Grand Suite are designed to have wood-burning fireplaces, stocked up daily with fresh baskets of firewood. There is a personal streaming audio system with virtually thousands of titles available at your fingertips. Your personal iPad introduces the world of Pädaste and Muhu Island, PS3 plays Blu-ray HD movies. Views over the parklands and the shores of the Baltic Sea are spectacular and unique. Extra day pillows invite to rest, relax and daydream.

Alexander Restaurant

Our fine dining restaurant 'Alexander' takes its name from Alexander von Buxhoeveden, the last noble owner of the Pädaste Estate. Alexander is situated in the former main hall of the Manor, opening into the winter garden with sweeping views over the park with ancient trees. Alexander serves Nordic Islands' Cuisine with reference to local traditions and the seasons in a casual elegant setting.

Each evening, our chef presents a daily changing 3-course table d'hôte menu and a 5-course degustation menu. Alexander Restaurant earned the title Best Restaurant of Estonia in 2013, 2012, 2011 and 2010.

Pädaste Yacht Club serves a choice of world cuisine dishes during the summer months for lunch and early dinner. Weather permitting; we will serve pre dinner aperitifs on the terrace.

The Bar

Our clients will be delighted to enjoy the setting of our comfortable and convivial bar with an open wood fire and that special Muhu atmosphere, inviting for a cup of coffee, a beer, an aperitif before dining, or to have a chat with fellow guests. Service is immaculate and Pädaste's Dry Martinis and Cranberry Daiquiris are unforgettably good.

The Cellar

Adjacent to our well stocked wine cellar, 'The Cellar' is an intimate tasting room which will also be available for bespoke events, a wine tasting maybe or a private dinner for up to 12 guests. Dating back to the 14th Century, The Cellar forms part of the original part of Pädaste Manor, at that time the perfectly square room with the vaulted ceilings used to house the furnaces of the manor.

The Billiard Room

Our billiard room invites to a game of classic carambole, whereas deep club chairs by the open fire welcome smokers to enjoy a fine cigar from our well-stocked humidor.

Poetry Loft

A set of steep stairs in room number fifteen leads to the poetry loft; here - totally surrounded by hundreds of books - the booklover is cocooned in a reading chair - a narrow window invites to gaze at the sky and contemplate.

Accommodation at the Manor House

Deluxe double rooms, superior double rooms, exquisite junior suites and the sumptuous grand suite are superbly appointed with finest furniture, exquisite linen and fabrics, providing all amenities expected by today's discerning travellers. All rooms at the Manor House are air conditioned and offer views either over the park or the Baltic Sea.

Accommodation at the Carriage House

Once the home of the Barons' riding-horses and caleches, the Carriage house has been renovated with much attention to detail and houses a double room, 6 junior suites and two superior junior suites. Each junior suite has a private balcony overlooking the park and sea. A cozy lobby with fireplace and grand piano can be found on the ground floor.

Except for our superior junior suites Moon and Dagen, all junior suites in the Carriage House are similar in size, outfit and comfort. Every junior suite can accommodate 1 extra guest on a pullout couch on the first floor.

Accommodation at the Private Farm House

The Farm House is a historical 18th century log house with a thatched roof, where the steward of the Manor would convey with the laborers to assign daily works.

After a delicate restoration, the Farm House has retained many of its original features and soul, while the quality of accommodation is of a truly high standard.

The Farm House is located in a secluded angle of our property amidst an apple orchard, 50 meters from our reception area. In the Farm House our guests will be able to enjoy the use of two master bedrooms with adjacent bathrooms, The Farm House has a living with a fireplace, a cozy library with veranda and a seclude private garden. A further two beds are available in a small junior double on the ground floor while there is the possibility for two extra beds on pullout couches in the entertainment room.

The balcony of one of the master bedrooms and the private terrace of the Farm House, have a magnificent view towards the bay. To maintain the privacy character, the Farm House is available for bookings by one party or family only.

We are delighted to inform our clients that as a sign of our times all guest rooms and public rooms at Pädaste Manor are non-smoking - except for the Billiard Room where smoking is permitted.

Renewable resources

In order to conserve energy, the heating and cooling systems in the Manor House make use of ground heating technology as an energy source. This results in 70% of our energy requirement for heating and cooling being provided by own non-fossil resources.
